Professional Learning Institute

The Professional Learning Institute's upcoming Autumn School holiday program offers teacher, school leaders and school support staff the chance for extra professional learning. It follows the successful winter and spring school held last year.

Autumn School will be held over five days from Monday 20 April to Friday 24 April 2009 at Mt Lawley Senior High School and is offered free to all Department of Education and Training teachers, school leaders, business managers, registrars and school support staff.

Feedback from participants in 2008 was very positive and prompted the PLI to run the program again this year. There are half day, full day and two day learning modules of which many count towards the professional learning requirement for teacher re-registration with WACOT and for Senior Teacher classification.

All participants receive a certificate of participation and have the chance to meet and establish new professional networks in a relaxed atmosphere.

Morning tea and lunch provided for those who take part in whole day sessions.

Participants can attend for as little as half a day or as much as their interest, need and time allow throughout the five day program.

While participation is free, some modules require the purchase of learning materials from the presenters on the day. Detailed information is available online, including names of presenters, dates, anticipated audience, duration, module material costs and maximum participant numbers.
